

How to Sculpt your *Carole Shiber* Table Linens:

Steps 1 & 2: *Lift* and *Pinch*. Like crimping a pie crust.

Lift up on the edge while holding down the inside with your finger, hand, or a bowl or plate as a guide.
TIP: Do this on a tabletop, it's easier.

Pinch at the "crotch."



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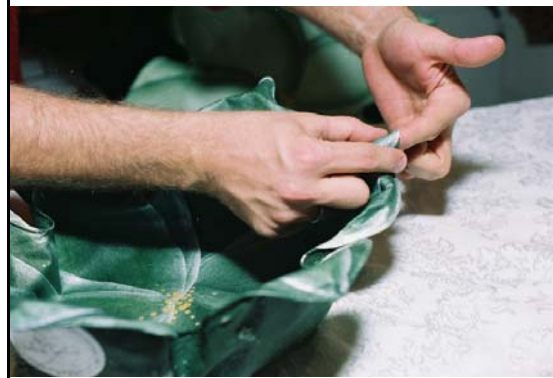
Step 3: Continue lifting and pinching around the piece at the natural indentations, or 'pinch points'. Depending on each design, there are 4-6 pinch points.



Step 4: '*Sculpt*' the leaf or petal edges. While holding the pinch points together with one hand, roll the edges down with your other hand. Continue sculpting around the entire design. Shape and style to your taste.



TIP: Pinching at the tip of a leaf or petal gives a little "extra personality."



NOTE:

If 'sculpting' these fine table linens does not come naturally, exercise a bit of patience & practice... This is, after all, table *Art!*

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Sponge or spot clean with a warm, soapy sponge. Steam iron wrong side, as needed, *only* if it makes you happy. Here's to many happy gatherings around your table!
